- The last date for submission of the Abstract is July 31, 2011. There is a maximum word count of 300 words.
- Please send it as an email attachment to [fhno2011@gmail.com](mailto:fhno2011@gmail.com)
- It should be structured as Title, Authors name, Author affiliation, Objectives, Methodology, Results and Conclusions. Table and Figures should not be submitted as part of the abstract.
- It is mandatory for the presenting author to register for the meeting.
- Only 12 papers will be accepted for the oral presentation based on the recommendation of the scientific committee. 10 min will be given to each speaker for oral presentation that includes 2 mins of question & answer session.
- Those papers not accepted for oral presentation will be considered for poster session based on merits. The size of poster should not be more than 3 x 3 feet
- The screening of the abstracts will be done by the abstract committee and their decision will be final. All the authors will be informed about the acceptance of their abstracts by August 31, 2011.
- All papers from India will be considered for presentation in the FHNO program. Papers submitted from rest of the countries will be considered in the ASHNO program. Please clearly mention whether you are applying for FHNO or ASHNO program.
- We have 2 awards each for the best papers as well as the best posters presented during this meeting. Separate awards will be given for FHNO and ASHNO sessions.

**By road from the airport (Dabolim):** A driving distance of approximately 21 kilometers. The landmark to look for is Goa Medical College. Further from which you need to take your first left which is an inclined road. The Grand Hyatt Goa is located in Bambolim near the Aldeia De Goa.

**From the railway station:** The main railway station in Goa is Margao (21.8 kilometers) and Vasco (25.4 kilometers). The closest sub station is Karmali which is approximately 12 kilometers.

**From the bus stop:** The closest bus stop is the Panjim bus stop, where all the buses travelling to Mumbai, Bengaluru and other destinations halt. A local bus going to Goa Medical College (Commonly referred as GMC) or a taxi can then be hailed.
